





Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011

NOTICE OF SERIES

The Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011 is organized by the Royal Yacht Squadron, the New York Yacht Club, the Royal Ocean Racing Club and the Storm Trysail Club.

1 MANAGEMENT

- 1.1 The New York Yacht Club Regatta Association, Inc. is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011. The Organizing Committee for the Race comprises the Royal Yacht Squadron (RYS), New York Yacht Club (NYYC), Royal Ocean Racing Club (RORC) and Storm Trysail Club (STC). The Authority and Committee will work in concert with host clubs for each of the individual races in planning and conducting the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011.
- 1.2 Participating yacht clubs will include organizing yacht clubs for each of the seven qualifying races and Yacht Clubs entering teams.
- 1.3 The OA will have the authority to interpret the conditions governing the series and reserves the right to accept or reject the entry of any yacht.

2 RULES

Participation in each qualifying race will be subject to the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for each individual event.

3 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 Yachts entering the Transatlantic Race 2011 and any two of the selected events in the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011 shall be deemed to be entered in the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series.
- 3.2 A yacht club may enter one or more team(s) consisting of two yachts by submitting the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011 Team Entry Form. Other than the Transatlantic Race 2011, yachts on a team do not have to compete in the same qualifying races. Yacht clubs entering a team will be included as participating yacht club.
- 3.3 There is no entry fee to participate in the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011.

4 SCORING

- 4.1 The Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011 consists of seven races. In order to qualify, a participating yacht shall compete in a minimum of three races, one of which shall be the Transatlantic Race 2011.
- 4.2 The seven qualifying races and their starting dates are:

Pineapple Cup - Montego Bay Race	February 5, 2011
RORC Caribbean 600	February 21, 2011
Annapolis to Newport Race	June 3, 2011
Transatlantic Race 2011	June 26 through July 3, 2011

Rolex Fastnet Race	August 14, 2011
Biscay Race	September 11-12, 2011
Rolex Middle Sea Race	October 22, 2011

- 4.3 A minimum of ten (10) IRC yachts must start in a qualifying race for that race to count in the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011.
- 4.4 Races will be weighted equally at 1.0 with the exception of the Transatlantic Race 2011 which will be weighted at 1.5.
- 4.5 Series Points will be awarded in IRC overall notwithstanding any class combination or division in a particular race. Points are the points awarded through the Cox Sprague system. See the table in Addendum A to this Notice of Series. RRS Appendix A is changed; paragraphs A2, A4 and A9 shall not apply. A boat retiring shall receive zero points.
- 4.6 A yacht's score for the Atlantic Ocean Racing Series 2011 will be the sum of her points, as described in paragraph 4.5, for the Transatlantic Race, multiplied by 1.5, and her two highest scoring qualifying races, multiplied by 1.0. Yachts will be ranked, with the highest score winning the Series.

5 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for individual and team entries. A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

6 PRIZE AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded at the New York Yacht Club annual awards dinner at the 44th Street Clubhouse in New York City in November 2011. All prize-winners will be invited to attend. Interpretation of the terms of all trophies and prizes will be by the OA.

After place 50, points reduce for each subsequent place by 0.3 to a flat minimum of 11.0
